CLOSE OF ENTRIES/POST ENTRIES

- Entries must be postmarked by **June 4th** to be eligible for the early entry fees.
- Entries postmarked after June 4th or received at the show will be charged the listed post entry fees.
- Horses that qualify after the close of entry deadline will be charged the pre-entry class fee for those specific classes.
- Entries close at **6:00 p.m. Tuesday** for Wednesday's pre-show classes & Wednesday's championship classes.
- For Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday classes, entries close at **6:00 p.m. the evening prior** to the day the class is scheduled to be held.

STABLING (see also General Information #24)

- All horses must have an individual stall.
- Bedding is NOT provided; shavings and hay are available for purchase. No grain is available.
- Tack stalls may be limited at the discretion of Competition Management based on the number of horses officially entered in the Region 10 Championship Show with all fees paid in full.
- Absolutely no stalls will be held without payment in full at the closing of pre-entries.
- Stalls will be available starting at Noon, Monday, June 23rd. Check Reg 10 facebook page on Monday for updates on earlier arrival before noon, or text Hillary at (651) 303-1411. Each horse will be assigned a separate stall (except mares with suckling foals). All horses must depart by 10 A.M. Monday, June 30th. Fines may be imposed for late departures.
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TBA CLASSES

- A number of TBA slots are restricted to the type of class that can be purchased; see class schedule. These restricted TBA classes are considered unrestricted if not requested by the close of entries.
- The following classes cannot be requested as TBA classes: any classes requiring a pattern (unless listed otherwise in the class schedule), Dressage, Western Dressage, Cow classes, Hunter Over Fences, Jumper, Carriage Driving classes.
- TBA class purchase fee is **\$150** for regional championship classes, in addition to the class entry fee, and must be received by the show secretary prior to close of entries.
- TBA class purchase fee is **\$35** for pre-show classes, in addition to the class entry fee, and must be received by the show secretary prior to close of entries.
- No additional post entry fee will be charged for TBA classes, only the normal class entry fee.
- If a minimum of four (4) eligible and paid entries are received for a TBA class, all but \$15 of the TBA fee will be refunded.

IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION – please read before completing entry forms

1. Only one-horse entry per entry blank; use an additional entry blank if the same owner is entering additional horses. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form.
2. Farm name may not be used unless stable, or farm is the owner appearing on the registration papers, or the stable or farm has been registered with USEF and the number noted on the space provided on the entry form. A copy of the USEF Farm Registration Certificate should accompany the entry.
3. To facilitate handling of entries, please follow the instructions below carefully.
4. Incomplete entries will not be issued exhibitor numbers until all information is provided. An **Incomplete Entry Fee** of **\$25** will be assessed to entries lacking required membership cards, registration papers, etc.
5. Junior exhibitors are 18 and under as of their actual age on December 1, 2024.
6. When making entries, be sure to include:

Complete copy of **registration papers** for each horse entered, showing ownership and registration information. If the owner's name on the registration papers is different than on the entry for the horse, an affidavit, a copy of the sales contract, or authorization form must be on file with the show office.

Negative Coggins Test. Original results within the last 12 months must be presented in the Show Office. To expedite processing, a copy must be mailed with the entries.

Copy of current **USEF membership** card for each owner, trainer, rider, driver, and handler. Adult exhibitors (19 and over) in amateur classes must have a USEF amateur designation. **USEF Show Pass applications must be completed online at <https://www.usef.org/show-pass>.** **As of 12/12023, only one USEF Show Pass is allowed per year and there are some categories of individuals who are not eligible for a USEF Show Pass. Please contact USEF with any questions.**

Copy of current **AHA membership/competition** card for each owner, trainer, rider, driver, and handler. AHA membership, with a competition card, is required for all Regional Championship classes. Exception: Leadline riders.

Signatures are required for each owner, rider, driver, handler, coach whose name appears on the entry form. If an exhibitor is under the age of 19, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, trainer, must sign the entry blank on the minor's behalf.

Signed check payable to Region 10 Championship Show, in US funds, or a **valid credit card**, covering all fees associated with the entry must accompany the entry forms. Entries received without full payment will be considered post entries. OR

Credit card. Please use separate form to submit credit card information and include form with entries.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. OFFICIAL REGION 10 CHAMPIONSHIP PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

No professional photographers, other than the official show photographer, may take pictures in the show ring(s) or from the rail(s). Professional Photographers, defined as individuals who have or will have photography services or images for sale, are not permitted to photograph in the ring or from the rail without prior written permission by the Region 10 Show Committee. Additionally, watermarked or signed photography will be considered professional photography and will not be allowed to be posted on any media outlets.

Anyone who attends the Region 10 Championship gives Region 10 permission to utilize and publish photos taken at the Region 10 Championship by the official photographers/videographers and/or staff at no charge. No written release is required for Region 10 to use or publish these photos in their promotional material.

Media Press/Equine Industry Pass credentials may be issued by Region 10, and with permission of the official show photographer, to credentialed journalists, photographers, and videographers from recognized non-equine or equine industry magazines, newspapers, and publications.

Any suspected violation of this rule must be submitted to the Region 10 Show Committee for review. Any person found in violation of these rules will be required to pay a \$1,200 fine to Region 10 or will be escorted from the grounds.

GENERAL INFORMATION

“EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.”

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

1. **CHANGES:** The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors.
2. **OFFICIALS:** In the event that due to illness or failure of a Show Official to attend the shows or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a Show Official.
3. **CANCELLATION OR SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES:** Exhibitors cancelling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit office fees. No substitution of horses will be permitted. Entry fee refunds will be made only with the presentation of an acceptable veterinarian certificate which must be on file with the Show Secretary by the end of the Show. Once a horse is on the grounds, the entry fee refund will only be made with the presentation of an acceptable veterinarian's certificate from the official Show Veterinarian. Stall refunds will be made at the discretion of Show Management.
4. **CLOSE OF PRE-ENTRIES:** U.S. Government postmark dates will be used to determine close of pre-entries. Metered postmarks are not acceptable.
 - a. Entries must be postmarked by **June 4th** to be eligible for the early entry fees.
 - b. Entries postmarked after **June 4th** or received at the show will be charged the listed post entry fees
 - c. Horses that qualify after the close of entry deadline will be charged the pre-entry class fee for those specific classes.
 - d. Entries close **6:00 p.m. Tuesday** for Wednesday's pre-show classes & Wednesday's championship classes.
 - e. For Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday classes, entries close at **6:00 p.m. the evening prior** to the day the class is scheduled to be held.
5. **USEF FEES:**
 - a. A **\$23** Federation Fee will be collected & remitted to USEF for every horse entered in the competition. (\$15 D&M + \$8)
6. **AHA FEES:**
 - a. 9-90 Education/Evaluation Fee: **\$5** per horse for the pre-show and **\$20** per horse in the championship show will be collected & remitted in their entirety to AHA.
 - b. AHA Post Competition Fee: **\$7** per horse entered in the pre-show and **\$7** per horse entered in the championship show. These fees are submitted in their entirety to AHA.
 - c. A Single Event Fee of **\$40** will be assessed for each AHA non-member entered in the Pre-Show. AHA membership, with a Competition Card, is REQUIRED in the Championship Show.
7. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:**
 - a. Purebred Arabian horses entered in the show must be registered with the Arabian Horse Registry of America and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry.
 - b. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses entered in the show must be registered in the Half-Arabian and/or AngloArabian Registry or have a CPAR permit.

- c. Horses must be entered in their full registered name. Registration number and sire and dam must appear on the entry blank.
 - d. A copy of the registration papers showing ownership must be submitted with the entry form.
 - e. See USEF rule AR110.4e regarding co-owned horses shown in amateur owner classes.
- 8. HEALTH PAPERS:**
- a. **EIV and EHV:** All horses over the age of seven (7) months must have been vaccinated within the past six (6) months.
 - b. **Negative Coggins Test.** Original results within the last 12 months must be mailed with pre-entries or presented in the Show Office for post entries.
- 9. PAYMENTS – IN US FUNDS:**
- a. Open Checks: All pre-entries and stall reservations must be accompanied by fully negotiable checks (no “open checks”) dated on or before the date of close of entries, or a valid credit card. Entries without such checks will be considered post entries and charged post entry fees; stalling priority will also be negated.
 - b. Credit Card: If you will be using a credit card for payment for all or part of your entries, stall requests, sponsorship, patron package, etc., please complete the credit card authorization form and include it with your submissions. **Include a 4% convenience fee in the total amount due.**
 - c. If an exhibitor has failed to pay entries or submitted a non-negotiable payment in the past, the competition can require a cashier check or valid credit card payment to compete at future competitions. If money is owed to Region 10 from a past regional competition, entry to this competition will not be accepted until the prior debt is paid in full with a valid credit card or cashier check.
 - d. NSF Checks or declined credit card: A **\$100** penalty will be assessed each time a check is presented to the Region 10 bank and returned due to non-sufficient funds; **\$50** if credit card is declined. Previous violators may be asked to submit payment for the current year via certified check or money order.
- 10. SHOW TABS:** Any exhibitor wishing to purchase additional shavings, add classes or make changes in entries at the show office will be required to leave a signed check payable to Region 10. Show Tabs must be settled by end of classes Sunday. Those accounts that have not been settled by exhibitors will be charged a **\$25** closing fee by the show office, checks will be filled out, and the accounts will be closed. For your convenience, we suggest that you audit your Show Tab and make settlement at the earliest possible time to avoid delays and to obtain account information.
- 11. PHYSICAL INSPECTION:** All animals are subject to a physical inspection, at no charge, by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of Show Committee as a safeguard against communicable diseases. Examination or treatment not requested by the Show Officials/management shall be on a private practice basis.
- 12. ATTENDANTS/GROOMS/HEADERS:** No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, their assistants, and Show Officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by the judge. In classes where headers are permitted, each header must be properly attired in a plain, unmarked smock, business attire, or appropriate show attire.
- 13. CONTROLLED PADDOCK:** See posted information on assistance of halter horse entries into the ring.
- 14. STALLIONS:** May be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors except in Walk/Trot, Leadline, and JTH Showmanship classes where no stallions are permitted. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions two years and over may compete in any HA/AA performance class open to stallions.
- 15. CALL FOR CLASSES:** Classes will be called promptly. The two-minute rule will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. Tack changes must be reported to the Paddock Manager at least two classes ahead to permit proper notification to ring officials. All tack changes must be made in paddock area
- 16. SPLIT CLASSES:** Show Management reserves the right to split any class that they deem necessary. All split classes will be split by exact age.
- 17. NO SHOWS:** A **\$50** penalty will be assessed for a “no show”. If you have entered a class and are not going to show in that class, you must notify the Show Office and Gate personnel before that class enters the ring, or you will be charged the “no show” penalty fee.
- 18. SMOKING:** . Smoking is NOT permitted in any indoor arena, show office or barn areas, including vendor trailers and/or tents.
- 19. PETS:** All dogs or pets must be held on a leash of less than six (6) feet in length or otherwise restrained. Dogs are not permitted in the Pavilion except certified service dogs or service dogs in training.
- 20. CAMPING** Parking of Trailer, campers, etc., will be directed by Alliant Energy Center. A permit will be required to park a mobile home on the grounds. They are **Not** available in the horse show office. See grounds personnel for parking permits.
- 21. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:** Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 22. STABLING:** Box stalls (with doors) are available. Tack stalls may be limited if entries warrant. Absolutely no stalls will be held without payment in full at the closing of pre-entries. **ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE A STALL.** All horses must be assigned a separate stall (except mares with suckling foals.)
- a. Stalls will be available after **Noon. on Monday, June 23rd, 2024.**
 - b. All horses must depart by 10:00 a.m. Monday, June 30th, 2024. Fines may be imposed for late departures.
- 23. WARM-UP AND COMPETITION ARENA:** The horse show will be held in the New Holland Pavillion 2. The warm-up area will be 100’x200’, the footing consists of dirt and sawdust. The indoor competition footing consists of dirt and sawdust and is 100’x250’. There will be a second warm-up in Pavillion 1 and is 100’x200’ and is Keiser footing
- 24. SHARPS CONTAINERS:** Sharps containers for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments will be located in the barns. Competition management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents, up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- 25. FARRIER:** An Official Show Farrier will be available on the grounds. No other farriers will be permitted to work on the grounds without registering with the Region 10 Show Committee. Exhibitors wishing to use their private farrier must have the farrier apply at the Show Office and pay a registration fee of \$100 before they can work on the show grounds.
- 26. VETERINARIANS:** Any veterinarian other than the Official Show Veterinarian who wishes to treat any horse at the show must register with the Region 10 Show Committee and pay a \$500 license fee and agree to be bound by the rules of USEF and AHA.

- 27. PRINTING ERRORS:** The Show Committee is not responsible for any errors in printing. Any corrections to the prize list will be posted in the Show Office.
- 28. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** Show management reserves to itself the power to refuse an entry or to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show, for just cause, without being liable for compensation.
- 29. COVID-19:** All state, federal and local COVID-19, including USEF obligations, CDC recommendations and Wisconsin State Department of Health requirements shall be enforced during set up, tear down and during the duration of the Show. By being on the Show Grounds, you agree to abide by all requested safety protocols. The USEF action plan can be found at [Coronavirus Resources | US Equestrian \(usef.org\)](#).
- 30. PERFORMANCE HORSE RULE CHANGE:** AR123.7. f A Ten Point Penalty must be assessed for an unnatural tail carriage, see AR105.2b AR106.7 Horses competing in Performance

Halter classes must be shod in accordance with the rules of the Performance class through which they qualified

- 31. TONGUE STABILIZER, AR105.11 Exception:** A single inconspicuous tongue stabilizer, made of soft, pliable material that gently secures the tongue in its normal position against the lower mandible, is permitted in the show ring for any horse competing in Park, English Pleasure, Country English Pleasure, Mounted Native Costume, English Show Hack, Formal Driving, Pleasure Driving, Country Pleasure Driving and Saddle Seat Equitation and for use by any horse competing in Ladies Side Saddle in English Show Hack attire (see AR156.1a) or in English attire (see AR132.1a), Walk-Trot/Walk-Jog 10 & Under in English attire (see AR132.1a) and ATR/JTR/AATR WalkTrot/Walk-Jog 11 and Over in English attire (see AR132.1a). Only one tongue stabilizer may be used on a horse and the tongue stabilizer must not restrict blood flow to the tongue and/or cause discomfort to the horse.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time. B.
